**SCOPE** The Building 35A project at the West Haven VA Medical Center initially began as a major roofing replacement project. However, it quickly expanded into a more comprehensive endeavor that included framing, addressing water damage, installing new sheathing, HVAC upgrades, lightening protection, mold remediation, drywall installation, demolition, and ceiling work.

## WORCESTER AIRPORT ROOF REPLACEMENT

**CONTRACT COMPLETION**, July 2022

**CONTRACT VALUE** \$93.5K

**SCOPE** The project involved removing the existing roof system down to the metal deck and carefully handling the lightning protection system for reinstallation. Deteriorated wood blocking was replaced, and new blocking was added to align with the insulation system. A sealed 10-mil polyethylene vapor retarder was installed, followed by R-30 polyisocyanurate insulation with tapered crickets and a 1/2" high-density cover board, mechanically fastened with PVC-coated plates and screws positioned to avoid conduits. All penetrations were flashed and sealed, and new scupper boxes, downspouts, and PVC-coated edge metal were fabricated and installed. Base flashing was added at the Control Tower wall.

**SCOPE** This project involved replacing 18 windows in the Air Traffic Control Tower shaft and repairing surrounding drywall and ceilings to ensure proper fit and weather tight seals. Various interior & exterior doors, in the tower and base building were replaced or adjusted, including frames, hardware, and access control systems, ensuring they functioned as intended.

**SCOPE** The Overton Brooks VAMC project in Shreveport, LA, corrected electrical deficiencies in Building 4. Work included replacing the transformer, upgrading lighting, relocating and upgrading panels, and installing ventilation and cooling in Closet 4-4. Two new rooms were built for communications and electrical systems, and new automatic transfer switches with bypass isolation were installed. All panel circuits were identified and relocated to ensure safe clearances for maintenance and operation.

Interior work involved ceiling, wall, and flooring restoration, along with reinstalling fixtures and systems. All work followed VA, OSHA, and EPA standards, with daily cleanup and minimal disruption to hospital operations, and was completed within 180 days.
